## RATE OF PLAY

Fischer time control: 20 minutes plus 10 second increment from move 1. Any player arriving more than 15 minutes late for a round will be defaulted and their opponent repaired if possible.

## VENUE AND DIRECTIONS

St Faith's school is about a mile and a half south of the City Centre, on Trumpington Road, which leads to junction 11 of the M11. If you are not a local the easiest access is from junction 11. Drive for a little over two miles through Trumpington and towards the City Centre, and St Faith's is on the right-hand side after passing Bentley Road.

There should be ample car parking at the venue. Enter by gate 4 (the first reached on the right of Trumpington Road approaching from the south). Go to the hardstanding at the end of the drive. If necessary you can park on the road outside the school on Sundays or in Bentley Road.

Pedestrians and cars should both use gate 4, which will be open from 9am to a little after 10am. Should you arrive outside these times you will need to enter the code 2409 to gain access.

Cambridge station is about a mile from the venue. From the station walk west along Brooklands Avenue, turning left onto Trumpington Road and entering the school by gate 4.
