Ratings:

Players' July 2026 rapidplay ratings will be used to determine eligibility for tournaments, whilst the September ratings will be used for pairings and rating prizes.

For players without a rapidplay rating, their normal play ECF rating will be used instead. Unrated players must give an indication of their playing strength at the bottom of the entry form and select their tournament accordingly. We reserve the right to change the section entered for non-rated players.

Rate of play:

Fischer time control: 25 minutes plus a 10 second increment from move 1. Any player arriving more than 15 minutes late for a round will be defaulted and their opponent re-paired if possible.

General conditions:

Any disputes shall be referred to the Chief Arbiter whose decision shall be final. The organizers accept no responsibility for any loss, theft or accident during the tournament.

Data protection:

Personal data provided on the entry form will only be used for the purpose of running the rapidplay and letting you know of future such tournaments.

Prizes:

Major: £100, £60, £30

Challengers: £100, £60, £30

Minor: £60, £40, £25

The prizes above are guaranteed provided at least 65 entries.
