Prizes

First, second and third prizes will be awarded in each section and other prizes according to entry.

Clocks: Clocks may be used in all sections, at a time limit of 30 minutes per player per game; anyone unfamiliar with clocks will be given help.

Entry fee Adult/Junior sections £17.50, including £7.50 ECF fee; ECF Silver members (or above) may deduct £7.50 from this. Juniors only sections: £10; ECF Silver members may deduct £3.50. If numbers are small, sections may have to be merged.

Closing Date As space is limited, entries received after Thursday 23rd November may not be accepted

Players Anyone may enter whether they live in Norfolk or not. This is an open congress.

Grades ECF Rapidplay grades apply. If a player does not have a rapidplay grade then a standardplay grade will be used. If you have neither, then (unofficial) Norfolk junior grades will apply.
