**Prizes**

First, second and third prizes will be awarded in each section and other prizes according to entry.

**Clocks:** Clocks may be used in all sections, at a time limit of 30 minutes per player per game; anyone unfamiliar with clocks will be given help.

**Entry fee** Adults and Juniors in adult sections £17.50, including £7.50 ECF game fee; ECF members (Silver, Gold or Platinum) may deduct £7.50 from this.

Juniors only sections: £12; ECF Silver(or above) members may deduct £2. If numbers are small, sections may have to be merged.

**Closing Date** As space is limited, entries received after Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June may not be accepted

**Players** Anyone may enter whether they live in Norfolk or not. This is an open congress.

**Grades** ECF Rapidplay grades apply. If a player does not have a rapidplay grade then a standardplay grade will be used. Players without grades should give an indication of their experience with the entry.
