Covid-safety

ECF Membership – a word of explanation

1. Any junior who has not been an ECF member previously can have free Silver membership for one year. You may apply for this on the ECF website, then you will be eligible for the £2.50 discount.
2. Any junior who **has been** an ECF member can apply (online) for Silver membership (to play in tournaments) for £6; this will qualify for a discounted entry fee to most tournaments (including this one).
3. Any juniors who do not wish to have ECF membership may simply pay the £12.50 entry fee which includes payment for rating for this event.
