

Rating

Rapidplay ratings will be used where available; otherwise, long play ratings will be used. Unrated players will be assigned an estimate by the Controller. All results will be submitted to the ECF for their Rapidplay rating list. Ratings used for entry will be the November ECF Ratings and January ECF Ratings for pairings and prizes.

Clocks

Digital clocks will be used in both sections with a time limit of 20 minutes per player plus 10 seconds for each move.

Prizes

The winners of each section will receive prize money. Other prizes will be awarded. Prizes may be increased dependent on entry and at the Controller's discretion. Subject to entry, junior prizes will be awarded in the U1450 section. The highest placed Norfolk player will hold the Peter Burnett Cup for one year.

Sections

Sections are dependent on entry and the Controller reserves the right to merge sections. Where a higher fee may have been payable the transfer will be at no extra cost.

Refreshments

Tea, Coffee, and biscuits will be available. You may wish to bring your own food. There are Kitchen facilities, with a microwave at the venue. A small shop is within walking distance with two pubs a short drive away.

Byes and election to play in the championship

Players may request a half point bye in the 1st round with their entry. Players may elect to play in the Championship section if not eligible by rating.
