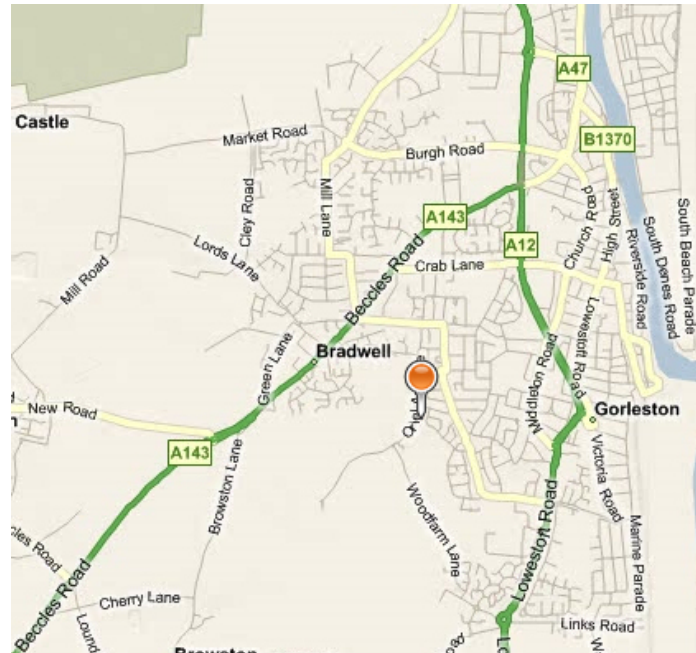

From Lowestoft - At first roundabout at end of A12 turn left past British Gas Beacon Structure, at next roundabout go straight over then take next turning right then immediately take left along Woodfarm Lane. Follow for about 1/2 mile school is on the right.

From Yarmouth - follow A12 to Lowestoft. At lights just before James Paget Hospital turn right down Brasenose Avenue. Follow road round until T Junction with Hertford Way. Turn Left until next T Junction. Turn Left along Oriel Avenue, School is down on the left.

From Norwich/Beccles - (Follow signs to Crematorium) At lights on Lloyds Pharmacy/Post Office corner turn right down Long Lane. Keep following Crematorium signs for next two T junctions finally turning right onto Hertford Way, At T junction take left along Oriel Avenue. School is down on the left.
